

2021 Zinfandel Hopland-Mendicino County Locavore Vineyard

Red berry, earth, oak aromas; smooth palate of cherry, pomegranate, boysenberry, black currant, dried herbs; vanilla, caramel, mocha undertones; seamless oak integration and acidity.



Tasting Notes:

Subtle aromas of a red berry blend mingle with a fusion of earth and toasty oak. The smooth entry quickly reveals red cherry, pomegranate, boysenberry, black currant, and a touch of dried herbs. Delicious threads of vanilla, caramel, and mocha weave through the wine, enhancing each sip while adding interest and depth. Seamlessly integrated oak and tannins lend support, while bright acidity showcases the delicious flavors that linger into the finish.

Food & Wine Pairings:

This nicely balanced wine will pair perfectly with eggplant lasagna, or a hearty bowl of minestrone sprinkled with fresh grated Parmesan cheese and served with fresh, hot sourdough bread.
